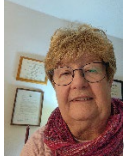

## Experiences of Mickey Nickelson

National: Recently became a member of the Service Committee. Now serving as parliamentarian for the Associates of NCCW. Was a part of the planning committee for the National Convention held in Minneapolis in 2022 (probably my most challenging and rewarding involvement with NCCW). Attended 10 NCCW Conventions.

Province: As Archdiocesan President and now past President I serve as a board member. One of my first duties was to plan the logistics of the quarterly meeting. Presidents give reports on their Diocesan activities at each meeting.

Archdiocese: As President of the St. Paul Deanery, I was a member of the Archdiocesan board where I served as Commission Chair for International, Community Concerns, and Organization. I served as ACCW President from 2021 – 2023 and now serve as Past President.

St. Paul Deanery and parish CCW: The road to becoming an Archdiocesan President began at the parish level. As a delegate from my parish to the St. Paul Deanery, lead me to serve as editor of the newsletter, secretary, treasurer, and president.

St. Paul Unit of Parliamentarians: This unit meets once a month for education and practice. I have been a member for the past 10 years and served as editor of the newsletter, treasurer, secretary and chair of the audit committee. The experience has served me well as president of CCW groups and as a member.

Kitui Partnership: Our diocese has a partnership with a parish in Kitui, Kenya under the direction of our Center for Missions. I now serve on the Leadership Committee, which supports parishes throughout the diocese who have a partnership with parishes outside of the United States and the Partnership Committee charged with communicating with Kitui's CWA (Catholic Organization of Women) and arranging host parishes, accommodations and site visits when they visit every three years. During the last six years, the ACCW raised over \$50,000 to build a dormitory for women, matching what the women in Kitui raised.

Locally: for the past 15 years, I have served as a coordinator to serve dinner to 150 – 300 guests at Catholic Charities and Loaves and Fishes.

When I joined Nativity of Our Lord Parish in 1983, I joined the choir and taught Religious Ed. I was a trustee for eight years. Twenty-five years ago, I co-chaired our Nativity County Fair (what some parishes refer to as their Fall Festival) raising over \$100,000. I continue to serve on Nativity's CCW.

After graduating from University of Minnesota Mankato, I taught for five years. While working on my masters, I joined what is now Wells Fargo bank and worked there for most seven years. I was asked to work in the Development Office of the Archdiocese. My response was "I do not know anything about raising money." Their response was "we can teach you how to raise money.
